# Renting Vs. Buying A Home

There are many things to consider when making one of the biggest decisions of your life. Here are a few big ones.

#### What's your budget and financial situation?

First things first: you need enough money to even consider buying a home. Down payments can vary greatly. A traditional one is 20% of the home's price, which then eliminates mortgage insurance.
